**Scholarship Grading Criteria:** The following weight factors will be used in the review of the applicants.

1. **GPA (Maximum 2 Points)**
  - a. 2.6 or above or GED Certificate      2 points
  - b. Below 2.59      1 point
  
2. **Family's Yearly Adjusted Gross Income (Maximum 5 Points)**
  - a. Family Income under \$25,000      5 points
  - b. Family Income \$25,000 - \$50,000      4 points
  - c. Family Income \$50,001 - \$100,000      2 points
  - d. Family Income \$100,001 +      1 point
  
3. **Number in your immediate family, including applicant (Maximum 5 Points)**
  - a. One family member      1 point
  - b. Two family members      2 points
  - c. Three family members      3 points
  - d. Four family members      4 points
  - e. Five and above family members      5 points
  
4. **Number of Family Members, including Applicant, in College (Maximum 5 Points)**
  - a. One family member      1 point
  - b. Two family members      2 points
  - c. Three family members      3 points
  - d. Four family members      4 points
  - e. Five and above family members      5 points

5. **Employment, including homemaker, stay-at-home parent, or caregiver** (Maximum 5 Points)
  - a. Unemployed or working less than 5 hours a week 1 point
  - b. 6 – 15 hours per week 2 points
  - c. 16 – 25 hours per week 3 points
  - d. 26 – 35 hours per week 4 points
  - e. 36 hours per week and above 5 points
  
6. **College Choice** (Maximum 4 Points)
  - a. In State College 4 points
  - b. Out of State College 1 point
  
7. **Volunteerism** (Maximum 3 Points)
  - a. Yes 3 points
  - b. No 1 point
  
8. **Achievement & Honors** (Maximum 2 Points) List honors accorded you such as Merit Scholarship, Valedictorian, Salutatorian, Citizenship awards, etc.
  - a. Yes 2 points
  - b. No 1 point
  
9. **Educational Objective/ Personal Essay** (Maximum 10 Points) Attach, to your application, a statement not to exceed one page in length of your educational plans and goals. In judging this item, phrasing, spelling, appearance, and depth of plans will be considered. It will be judged subjectively.
  
10. **Letters of Recommendation** (Maximum 4 Points) Attach two letters of recommendation from high school/college faculty, counselor, community center, church official, or employer. Each letter may earn 2 points.
  
11. **Special Circumstances** (Maximum 5 Points) Includes special needs of applicant or family member, military service, or any other special circumstance.
  
12. **Official High school/GED Certificate/College Transcript(s) must be attached to application.**
